

I was contacted by Metra employee Mrs. Rodriquez who was diligent and professional in her response. Unfortunately for me not all the people who received that letter where as co operative. So I am asking your office to help me with some of the missing information I am being denied by The Executive Director of the Chamber of Commerce Melisa McIntyre (who was not available once in the three attempts made by Metra to contact her on the issue of my letter).

I would like a list of names and contact phone numbers and mailing addresses of all current Officers and Board of directors for the Edison Park Chamber of Commerce. Official participating employment addresses will do fine. I would like any information other then the 6730 N Olmstead address or (773) 631-0063. I have a number of Register Mail receipts that where refused. Not to be confused with unable to deliver but "Refused".

I would like information on the insurer of the Edison Park Fest, Chamber office and any other event.

I am seeking information on the lease agreement between Metra and the Chamber, on any and all matters including but not limited to the Edison Park Fest, Farmers Market and day to day activities. The monthly rent and liability requirements if any.

I am interested to know if Metra has officially been notified of any vendors doing business on land owned by Metra including but not limited to Jump Guy Inc. or any valet companies and what those sublet agreements are if any. I would welcome any assistance your office can provide under the Freedom of information Act.
