Dear Mr. Opdycke:

We are in receipt of your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.* ("FOIA").

I. <u>Background</u>

On March 27, 2019, we received your request for any and all documents, Metra Police reports, incident reports, physical evidence, photographs, audio recordings, dispatch call/recordings, dash-cam video, and videos related to the arrest and detainment of on June 20, 2018 ("**Request**"). Your Request is denied.

II. <u>Denial</u>

Attorney Keith Pardonnet has determined that your Request for documents concerning the abovereferenced incident are exempt from disclosure in their entirety under Sections 7(1)(d)(i) and (vii) of FOIA, which states in part:

[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of \ldots any law enforcement \ldots agency for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that disclosure would \ldots

(i) interfere with pending or actually and reasonably contemplated law enforcement proceedings conducted by any law enforcement . . . agency that is the recipient of the request and . . .

(vii) obstruct an ongoing criminal investigation by the agency that is the recipient[.]

5 ILCS 140/7(d)(i) and (vii).

Metra Police Department has advised that this is an ongoing investigation. As such, any Metra Police reports, incident reports, physical evidence, photographs, audio recordings, dispatch call/recordings, dash-cam video, or videos related to the arrest and detainment of on June 20, 2018 is not available for release at this time.

III. <u>Right of Review</u>

You have the right to have the denial of your Request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor ("**PAC**") of the Illinois Attorney General's Office. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this partial denial letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.

You also have the right to seek judicial review of your partial denial by filing a lawsuit in the circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.
