Dear Mr. Evola:

Metra's FOIA Department ("FOIA Department") is responding to your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq. ("FOIA").

## I. Background

On August 20, 2019, the FOIA Department received your request for "copies of any [and] all materials that [Metra has] related to the incident, including but not limited to documents, reports or recordings (whether date, still, video, and/or audio, or otherwise) that show or describe the facts and circumstances related to incident, the scene, or investigation of the incident where was killed" ("Request"). Your Request is denied.

## II. Denial

Attorney Aruj Chaudhry has determined that your Request for documents concerning the abovereferenced incident are exempt from disclosure in their entirety under the following subsections of Section 7(1)(d) of FOIA, which states in pertinent part:

> [r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of .... any law enforcement . . . agency for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that disclosure would:

> (i) interfere with pending or actually and reasonably contemplated law enforcement proceedings conducted by any law enforcement . . . agency that is the recipient of the request; and

> (vii) obstruct an ongoing criminal investigation by the agency that is the recipient of the request.

## 5 ILCS 140/7(d)(i) and (vii).

The Metra Police Department has declared this incident as an ongoing investigation. Release of any records related to incident would therefore "interfere with pending ... law enforcement proceeding" and "obstruct an ongoing criminal investigation." As such, any records regarding this matter are not available for release at this time.

## III. <u>Right of Review</u>

You have the right to have the denial of your Request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor ("**PAC**") of the Illinois Attorney General's Office. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.

You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.
